Horrified by the refugee crisis in the Middle East and Europe, members of the IndoRelief team traveled to France and Greece to assist in refugee camps, make connections with other nonprofit organizations, and learn more about the situation from the refugees living in these areas. With networks established in the Middle East and in Europe, IndoRelief launched RefuRelief. We have ongoing projects in Syria, Lebanon, Turkey, Greece, France and the UK.
